Animal Welfare Courts. Several challenges are common to the criminal justice system response to animal abuse. These include the likelihood that defendants will be charged with misdemeanors rather than felonies, the low priority assigned to these cases by the criminal justice system, failure to take the cases seriously, and the discretion of prosecutors to drop prosecution of misdemeanor cases due to resources and other issues (Animal Legal Defense Fund, n.d.).
