Respiratory organs: The organs of the respiratory tract can be divided into two groups-the upper respiratory tract (nose, nasal cavity, sinuses, and pharynx) and the lower respiratory tract (larynx, trachea, bronchial tree, and lungs). Carbon dioxide is exhaled and oxygen is inhaled through the respiratory system, which includes muscles to move air into and out of the lungs, passageways through which air moves, and microscopic gas exchange surfaces covered by capillaries. The circulatory system transports gases from the lungs to tissues throughout the body and vice versa.
