Common Physical Therapy CPT Codes. The most commonly used CPT codes for Physical Therapy are listed below. For example, the CPT code for therapeutic exercise is 97110. The CPT code is listed on the left, the name of the code is in the middle and the description is in the right column. 97161.

Without further ado, below are the common codes associated with PT, according to CMS. (I took the liberty of removing the unspecified codes for those that allow specific laterality.) Pain in joint. M25.511. Pain in right shoulder. M25.512. Pain in left shoulder. M25.521.

Here is an example of ICD-10 and CPT codes in use: today, if you diagnose a patient with “Benign paroxysmal vertigo, bilateral,” you would use the ICD-10 code H81.13 to indicate your diagnosis. Then, you might complete standard canalith repositioning on your patient, in which case you would include CPT procedural code 95992 on your claim.

The most common CPT codes used by therapists are: 90791 – Psychiatric Diagnostic Evaluation 90792 – Psychiatric Diagnostic Evaluation with medical services 90832 – Psychotherapy, 30 minutes (16-37 minutes)

### ICD-10 Common Codes for Pelvic Rehab Providers

The number of CM Codes, or Diagnosis codes, jumped from 14,025 with ICD-9 to 69,823 with ICD-10. PCS Codes, or Procedure codes, jumped from 3,824 with ICD-9 to 71,924 with ICD-10. The CM codes are the ones we will be selecting in LTC – the PCS codes are “procedure codes” and are for use in the inpatient hospital setting.

ICD-10 codes represent diagnosis, and are the foundation of physical therapy coding. These codes are used by providers and physical therapy coders to classify ailments and injuries. This is a prerequisite for compliant documentation and claim reimbursement from payers.

Most of the CPT codes that are relevant to rehab therapists are located in the 97000 section (“Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation”). However, you can bill any code that best represents the service you provide as long as you can legally provide that service under state law.
