Note: in CSE style, titles of periodicals (newspapers, journals, magazines) are capitalized as they normally are; book titles and article titles have only the first word of the title (and of any subtitles), as well as proper nouns, capitalized. Obvious exceptions are capitalized abbreviations and symbols (e.g., HIV-1, DDAVP, pH).

CSE's name-year in-text reference takes the form of the author's last name and the year of publication, in parentheses. The Citation-Name style is probably the least used of the three CSE In-Text citation options. In this style, after the complete list of End References (aka the bibliography) is finalized, this list is alphabetized by first author surname and then numbered sequentially.

CSE Style was originally established for the biological sciences. It uses alpha references within the text. Many physical and engineering citation styles use numeric references within the text and are based on the American Chemical Society Style.
