FIM basics. -Measures one's ability to function w/independence.
-Score collected within 72 hrs of admission, 72 hrs before discharge & repeated again 80-180 days post. -Used by rehab to

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track facility ability for functional improvement (rated between the 2 scores) -Lower the score, the more money received.

Functional Independence Measure (FIM): The FIM is an 18-item, clinician-reported scale that assesses function in six areas including self-care, continence, mobility, transfers, communication, and cognition. Each of the 18 items is graded on

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a scale of 1-7 based on level of independence in that item (1 = total assistance required, 7 = complete independence). 7,8 FIM scores can be measured at admission to and discharge from inpatient rehabilitation.

Functional Independence Measure - an overview ...

Prior to training, her Pediatric Functional Independence Measure scores were 3 (moderate assistance) for all transfers, 2 (maximal assistance) for walking, and 1 (total assistance) for stairs. At 6 months, her scores were 6 (modified independence) for transfers, 5 (supervision) for walking, and 4 (minimal assistance) for stairs.
