However, John did not leave love undefined but described it as walking "according to His commandments" (2 John 1:6). This echoes the teaching of Jesus in John's gospel, where the Lord told His followers, "If you love Me, you will keep My commandments" (John 14:15). Our love is dependent on our obedience.

### Book of Second John Overview - Insight for Living Ministries

Study 3 in the studies on John's Gospel looks at three key issues raised in John 2:1-25: the miracles of Jesus, the honour and glory of God, and the issue of false belief.

### Study 3: John 2:1-25 - God's Word For You

(2:24-25) John exhorts his readers to adhere to the teaching they had originally received and not desert it for a "progressive" gospel. John has said this before (2:7; 2 John 5). Paul, too, had to urge his followers to reject any "different gospel" than the one they had originally been taught (2 Corinthians 11:4; Galatians 1:6-9).

### 3. Antichrists, Anointing, and Abiding (1 John 2:18-27 ...

John 1:26; John 1:33. Is the charge still true. Is Christ still unknown in His special prerogative as He that baptizeth with the Holy Ghost? I. Christ is not an absent force. —He is unseen. His bodily presence is removed from us for a time, but He is still in our midst the Captain of our Salvation, the Leader and Commander of His people.

John writes that this was true in his day; we could say it is even truer in our own. i.
