Medication Study Guide - NCDHHS

The medication calculation examination consist of 31 questions for Registered Nurses and 25 questions for Licensed Vocational Nurses of dosage calculations, I.V., and patient rights. You have one (1) hour in which to complete the examination. A score of 80% (25 correct) for Registered Nurses and (20) for Licensed Vocational Nurses is required to pass the examination.

NC DHSR ACLS: Study Tips for Medication Exam

Pull down on the lower lid. Instill drops into the center of the lower conjunctival sac. Apply ointment to lower conjunctival sac moving from the inner canthus to the outer canthus. If medication may be absorbed systemically, press on inner cants for 1-2 minutes after instilling drops.

You can use either method below (or an alternate method) to determine the answer. Method #1: Ratio Proportion. 125 mg = 100 mg 1 mL "x" mL Cross-multiply and solve for "x". 125 mg = 100 mg 1 mL "x" mL 125 "x" = 100 "x" = 100/125; "x" = 0.8 mL Method #2: Formula Method.

Medication Calculation Examination. Study Guide. D = Desired Dose. Q = Quantity of Solution. H = Strength on Hand. X = Unknown quantity of Drug. Sample: Physician orders 500 mg of ibuprofen (desired Dose) for a patient and you have 250 mg (Quantity on Hand) tablets (Quantity of solution) on hand. Solution: $D \div H \times Q = X$ 500mg \div 250 mg \times 1 tablet = 2 tablets.
