Changing lens aperture in Manual mode is a little tricky. First, make sure that the dial on the top of the camera is set to "M" position. Next, press and hold the +/- button located right below the camera shutter, then rotate the rear command dial to change aperture.

When you have your camera set to Manual (M) mode, the camera meter will give you a reading of the scene you are photographing, but it's your job to actually set both the f-stop (aperture) and the shutter speed to achieve a correct exposure. If you need a faster shutter speed, you will have to make the reciprocal change to your f-stop.
