The FSMA Produce Safety Rule does not require a written farm food safety plan but writing a plan helps growers get organized and focused on produce safety, as well as prepare for buyer requirements and third party audits. This food safety plan identifies all products and materials used to grow them that apply to this plan. The plan describes physical, chemical, and biological hazards that could occur and procedures for controlling them, including monitoring, verification and record keeping, for the following areas: water, soil amendments, field sanitation, production environment, and worker practices.

Sample Harmonized Food Safety Plan - Penn State Extension

A food safety plan does not need to be extensive and complicated—short and concise is better, in fact. Start small, and add to it as the season progresses or over a few years. A farm food safety plan is a living document that should be revised and added to over time. Similarly, you should remove outdated information and practices from your plan.
