### Special Tests - Physical Therapy Haven

There are many physical tests, or 'special tests', that are used by clinicians in physical therapy, and orthopedics / orthopaedics in general, during a physical examination. These tests are used to rule in or out specific musculoskeletal problems. They help in the differential diagnosis of orthopedic conditions and injuries. There are many such clinical orthopedic tests that target the various regions of the body and many tissue types including connective tissue, muscles, nerves, bones ...

### Hip - The Student Physical Therapist

A study by Levangie et al had developed a TIC for identifying Sij dysfunction with the following tests: standing flexion test, sitting PSIS palpation, supine long sitting test, and prone knee flexion test. The investigators assessed the diagnostic utility of those tests by comparing findings of patients who complained of LBP with those of patients being treated for other physical impairments not related to the back.

### Tests and Measures - Guide to Physical Therapist Practice

Active movements – flexion (significant limitation often pathological), extension, side flexion. Myotomes- rise from a knee squat (L3/4), walk on heels (L4/5) and walk on toes (S1/2). SLR (if leg pain or if you feel is needed for reassurance) +/- slump test.

Your physical therapist will test and screen for other, more serious conditions that could cause shoulder pain. To provide a definitive diagnosis, your physical therapist may collaborate with an orthopedic physician or other health care provider, who may order further tests, such as an X-ray to confirm the diagnosis and to rule out other damage to the shoulder, such as a fracture.

Your physical therapist will perform special tests to help determine a diagnosis of a groin strain, such as: Gently moving your leg away from your body Asking you to resist against his or her hand as he or she tries to gently push your leg outward (muscle strength test)
