A good catchlight can be found in each of these essential portrait lighting techniques. To pull it off, choose a light source that will have the shape you'd like—an umbrella for a round catch light, a softbox for a rectangular catch light, a simple reflector for a pin-point catch light, etc.—and set it up at low power.
