Klerman and coworkers tested the assumption that psychotherapy and psychopharmacology were essentially in conflict, each undermining the work

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of the other. There was no evidence that psychopharmacologic treatment led to therapy discontinuation or to symptom substitution or that psychotherapy exacerbated patients' distress.
