If someone is not doing timesheets, for example, and this is hurting the company because you sometimes have to delay invoicing, you could have a smart goal like "over the next 6 weeks, at least 5 weeks' timesheets will be completed by 10am of the next Monday morning." 6 weeks later you have a true or false; the developer made it or missed it.
